## THE UNIVERSITY OF SYDNEY WORLD SCHOLARS AWARDS 2010–2011

The University of Sydney World Scholars Awards provide financial support for academically gifted students undertaking a Doctor of Philosophy at the University of Sydney. Applications are invited from PhD candidates from selected countries, commencing at Sydney in March 2011.

### BENEFITS

- Full cost of tuition fees for up to 3 years
- Travel contribution of up to A\$1,250 each way

### ELIGIBILITY

World Scholars candidates must:

- Have a Firm Offer of Admission to a PhD at the University of Sydney;
- Commence PhD studies at Sydney in March 2011 (Semester 1);
- Be citizens of an eligible Participating Country (see below).

#### Eligible Countries

World Scholars applicants must be citizens of any of the following Participating Countries:

- **Asia:** Cambodia, Hong Kong SAR, India, Indonesia, Japan, Malaysia, Singapore, South Korea, Thailand, Vietnam

- **Europe:** France, Germany, Italy, the Netherlands, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, the United Kingdom
- **Americas:** Argentina, Brazil, Canada, Chile, Colombia, Mexico, the United States
- **Africa:** Kenya, Rwanda, South Africa
